2.1.2 INDUCTION

On the 24th and 28th of August, VESITConnect organized an Induction program for first-year students to introduce them to our college and the various other activities and councils of the college. There were two slots on each day slated between 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. The departments were divided as - CMPN and I.T on the first day. The second day was hosted by the departments of EXTC, AIDS, ECS, and AURO. The Induction on each day commenced with the opening speech of Gaurang Desai (BE I.T), student head of VESITConnect which was followed by all other prestigious societies and councils of the college. At first, the technical societies namely CSI (Computer Society of India), IEEE (Indian Institute of Electronics and Electrical Engineers), ISTE (Indian Society for Technical Education and ISA (International Association of Automation) gave their presentations about what they do, how they implement various technical aspects into real life and what they have to offer to the FEs. REPORT

Prarambh'23 commenced on the 3rd of September 2023, as A-CAP Admission rounds ended. Prarambh is an event exclusively designed for First Year students. All 12 classes engage in friendly competition to claim the coveted title of Best Class. Prarambh'23 comprised both Pre-events and Main day performances, with Pre-events taking place from 3rd to 14th of September and the Main Day being on the 15th of September 2023.

Starting off the event with Meme Challenge round 1, wherein all the classes were supposed to submit 3 memes to the council and after pairing those were put up for polls on @cult.vesit, Cultural Council's Instagram handle. Winners of the first round were expected to recreate a meme. The last round was the online submission of the meme in the form of a reel. The winners of the event are as follows:-

Promo Mania was an online video submission event in which all the classes had to endorse a product in the most creative manner. The event was an advertisement-making opportunity, with most of the classes actively submitting. Along similar lines of submission, we had Vlog Venture, an event giving the participants a chance to vlog their experience of the college. Music Video was the event where the participants were allowed to enact a song and make their own music video. Spoof It, was the last online video submission event where participants were expected to do a parody of a famous movie or series while emphasizing 'Gender Equality Campaign'.

After all online submissions that were done through Google forms, we also had two major offline submission events namely:-

(i) Collage making: All the classes were supposed to make a collage of photographs of all their classmates and submit it to the council which were then put up for display on the main day.

(ii) Moodboard: Each and every class was provided with an A2 size mountboard, out of which they were required to make a Moodboard with handmade drawings invoking the colour theme given to them. These Moodboards too were put up for display on the main day.

Then we had Fandom Buzzz, where 3 famous fandoms were selected through the polls on our instagram handle @cult.vesit. Participants were quizzed on the 3 selected fandoms followed by a Debate round on the same. The debate round also required them to present their views on 'Gender Equality Campaign'.

Group Dance auditions were taken up first and the team size required was 6-12 members per class and a time limit of 1.5-3 mins. Judges decided to qualify all the teams to the final round. Subsequently all of them performed on the main day.

The next up we had was Interclass Challenge in which classes were paired again and they were supposed to give fun challenges to each other which were supposed to be completed in the college.

The Artist Assemble preliminary round was an Audition from which selected participants were promoted to perform on the main day.

Debate was organized and had 2 rounds, round 1 being Oxford style and round 2 being the Balloon style. With a team size of 2 students, 6 teams were selected for round 2.

Conclurizz was our story writing event, wherein participants were provided with climax (i.e. ending line) and were then supposed to sketch out the entire story and the title which seamlessly leads to the given climax in a duration of 1 hour. The end lines given were:

(i) Looking down at the mysterious planet, the crew was astounded by what they had discovered and that it would challenge their understanding of the universe.

(ii) Little did they know that the haunting presence was about to reveal its true, malevolent form.

Mr & Ms Freshers round 1 was done through online form which consisted of personality and general perception based questions. Round 2 was a personal interview from which 5 boys and 5 girls were promoted to final round to be conducted on the main day.

Cult Studio was an interactive event conducted between 3 pm to 5 pm. It was an event consisting of many fun games and activities, aiming at forging new bonds amongst first-year students.

Treasure Hunt was the event with maximum participation, conducted a day before the main day. It was conducted in 2 rounds with 6 teams qualifying for the second round. The theme of treasure hunt was "Apocalypse".

Pre-events were carried out seamlessly leading to the Main Day. All the events of the main day were hosted by the members of the Senior Council. The schedule of the main day of the event was as follows:

12:00 Inauguration (lighting of lamp)

12:15 Artist Assemble

1:30 Mr Ms Freshers(R1)

2:20 Group Dance

3:30 Mr Ms Fresher (R2 & R3)

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF MAIN DAY:

Inauguration: The event commenced with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp by our respected Cultural Incharges; Dr. Nandini A(EXTC), Dr. Rohini T(Comps), Mr. Prasad G(Instrumentation); and the HOD of the Humanities Dept; Vivek Umrikar Sir. Both the Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. Manoj Sabnis, and Vivek Umrikar Sir enlightened the FEs with a few wise words.

Artist Assemble: The first event of the main day was the final round of Artist Assemble. Artist Assemble provides the first years the spotlight to shine and show off their various stage talents. Each performance was for a duration of 4-5mins. The judges for this event were students of the fourth year; Sejal Bishoyi, Niraj Divekar and Urvi Pandit. The winner of this event was Nidhi Puthran(D5A) who performed Lavni. Artist Assemble was hosted by Aradhya Ingle and Arya Raje.

Mr. Ms. Fresher: Mr. Ms. Freshers final round was further divided into 3 segments, the first one was the introduction and talent round.

The 2nd segment was a challenge round wherein participants were paired against each other to give dares.

The final segment was QnA round wherein our judges, the Mr. and Ms. Fresher of their year, Noel Dason and Madhura Mhatre asked the paired participants certain questions. Ryan D'Souza from D2C was declared as Mr. Fresher and Kamyra Gupta from D1EC was declared as Ms. Fresher for the year 2023. Mr. Ms. Fresher was hosted by Soham Shetye and Soham Tawade.

Group Dance: 11 classes participated in this event. Each class made groups of maximum 12 students and performed a group dance for a maximum duration of 4mins. The judges of the event were Harshali Gawade and Sheetal Dixit. The winners of group dance were the students of D2A. The event was hosted by Shreyas Patil and Ajay Iyer.

The points of each class were added up at the end resulting in D5A bagging the title of Best Class of the year 2023 with D1EC bagging Runner Up Best Class of 2023.

Prarambh 23 marked its end by thanking all the participants and supporting members and faculties along with a DJ played for students.
