
1. Low level signal processing

and student projects," says **Kala Vijayakumar**, an alumna of the University of Madras and president of **SSN College of Engineering** (estb.1996) which has 4,100 students mentored by 275 faculty on its muster rolls.

With Tamil Nadu (516) and Maharashtra (370) hosting the largest number of private engineering colleges in the country followed by Karnataka (212), it's hardly surprising that colleges sited in these three states dominate the national league

table. Tamil Nadu has 20 engineering colleges ranked among the private Top 100; Maharashtra 19 and Karnataka 17.

Beyond the Top 10, several institutions have risen in the EWIPEI Rankings 2019-20. Among them: **BMS College of Engineering, Bangalore**, ranked #15 (#21 in 2018), the **National Institute of Engineering, Mysore** #19 (36), **Vivekanand Education Society's Institute of Technology, Mumbai** #24 (29), **Go-**

karaju Rangaraju Institute of Engineering and Technology, Hyderabad #37 (47) and **Vidya College of Engineering, Meerut** #54 (74).

MOREOVER, IT'S pertinent to note that although some engineering colleges are modestly ranked nationally, they are highly ranked in their states.

For instance, the **Vivekanand Education Society's Institute of Technology, Mumbai** ranked #24 nationally is ranked #1 in Maharashtra (pop.115 million). Similarly, the **Rajagiri School of Engineering and Technology, Ernakulam**, ranked #39 all-India is #1 in Kerala (34 million), and **Heritage Institute of Technology, Kolkata**, ranked #74 nationally, is West Bengal's #1 private engineering college.

Dr. J.M. Nair, an alumna of IIT-Bombay and College of Engineering, Trivandrum and principal of the **Vivekanand Education Society's Institute of Technology (VESIT), Mumbai**, is delighted that VESIT is the top-ranked private "and rigorously administered" engineering college in India's most industrialised state. "We have great respect for the annual EWIPEI Rankings which are based on the assessment of knowledgeable leaders of industry and academia as also senior students in higher education. It is public acknowledgement that we provide high-quality industry-relevant engineering education to our students. VESIT has applied to the University of Mumbai for autonomy status, which we hope to get soon. Autonomous status is important because it will give us full freedom to update our curriculums, strengthen industry linkages, introduce interdisciplinary courses and focus on research, innovation and entrepreneurship," says Nair.

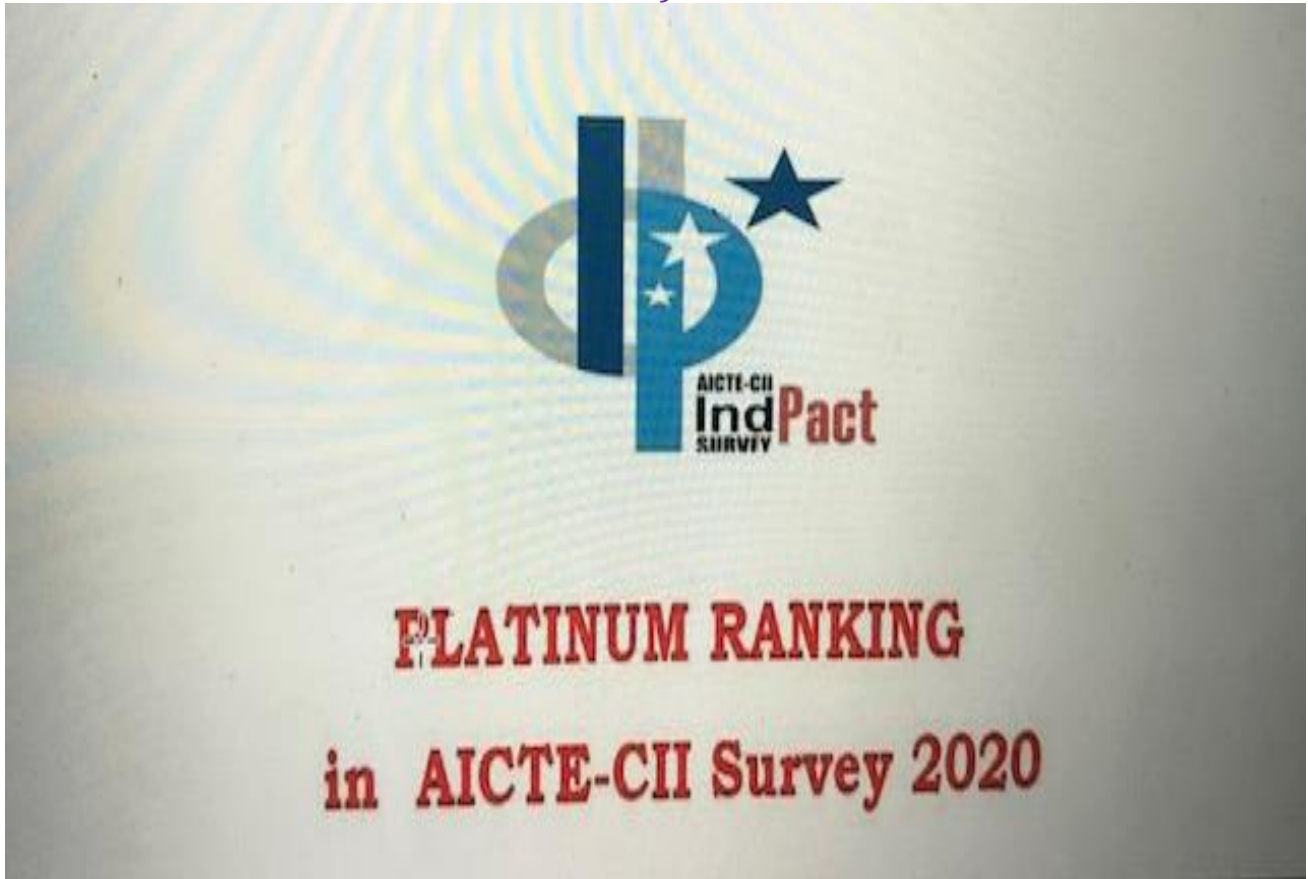

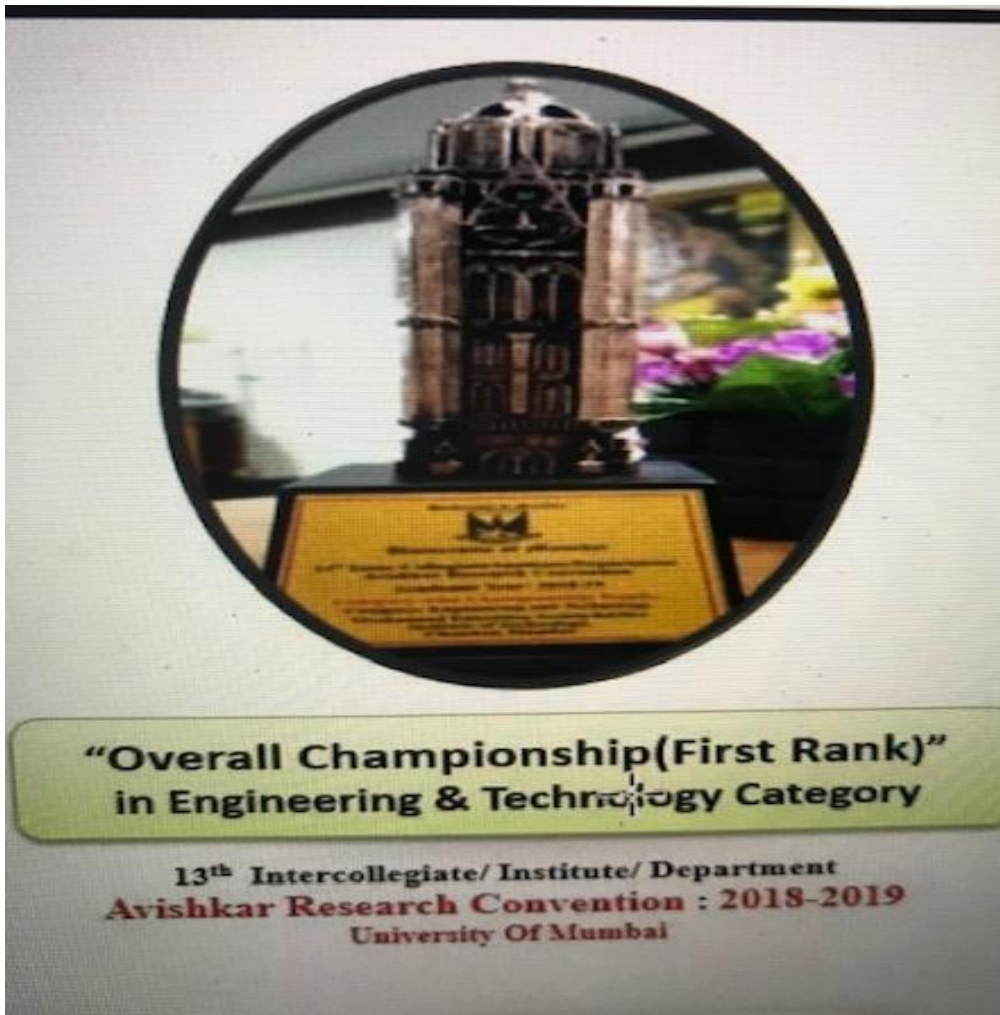

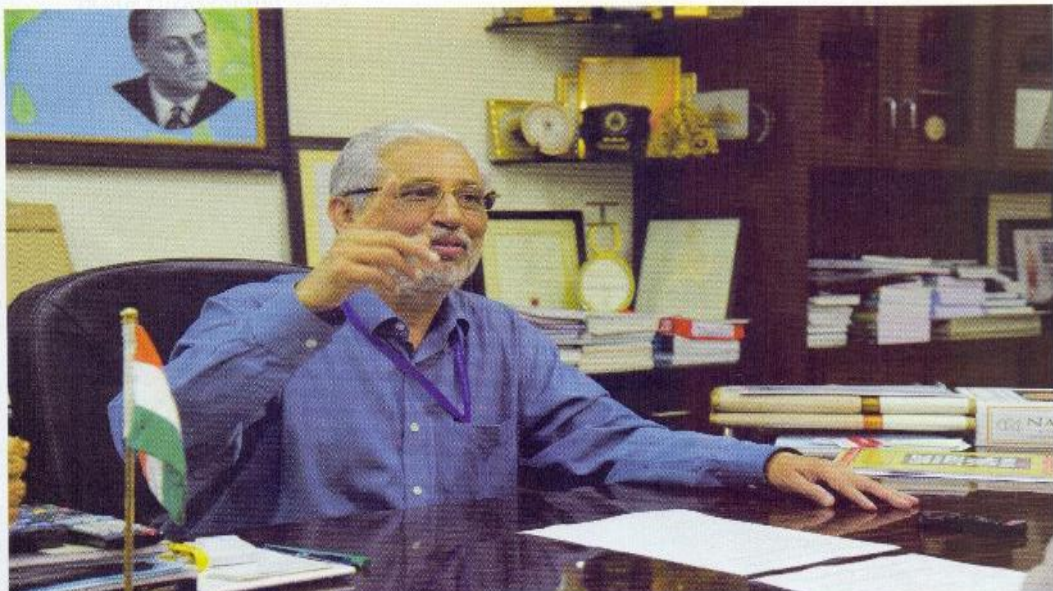

HOW WE RANKED TOP RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS

Indian academia match remarkably well globally in select disciplines such as materials science, chemistry, and physical sciences producing more output in renowned research indices, particularly in the last few years. Some of the institutions such as IISc Bangalore, the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs); Tata Institute of Fundamental Research; Indian Institutes of Science and Education Research (IISERs); Jadavpur University, Kolkata and even private universities such as Vellore Institute of Technology, Vellore; Manipal Academy of Higher Education, Manipal; SRM Institute of Science and Technology, Chennai; Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, Coimbatore; BITS Pilani and Thapar University are rubbing their shoulders with world class academic and research centres. As per Nature Springer study in 2017, India ranks second amongst the countries with highest increase in contribution to high-quality scientific research. India ranked fifth in research output lately, as per *Web of Science Analysis: Institute for Scientific Information, Clarivate Analytics*. India has also emerged as the top innovation destination in Asia and second in the World (Capgemini Report cited in IBEF-IPSR, 2017) for new innovation centres.

What does the research divulge?

The need for research ecosystem in the country is rapidly growing as more institutions are recognising the potential of new knowledge creation and transfer. The top 100 institutes record approximately a total of 50000 and 70000 publications per year in Web of Science and Scopus respectively, the average citation for the top 100 stand even at 3.72 in both the databases. This ranking not only supports the role of academic institutions in strengthening the national system of innovation; but intends to help those in dilemma to choose the best fit if they are interested in higher studies in science and engineering domain.

Methodology

For ranking of all such institutes that offer programmes in Science & Engineering, peer reviewed scholarly publication records were searched from Scopus® database of Elsevier which is one of the largest indexing and abstracting database with global coverage and from Web of Science (Expanded).

The Scopus database covers nearly 21,500 peer reviewed

journals including open access journals and nearly 113,000 books from over 5,000 publishers. The database includes content from about 452 journals from India which explains more content from India. The Web of Science, currently owned by Clarivate Analytics is the oldest indexing, abstracting and citation database, the 'core collection' of which includes more than 20,000 journals in Science, Social Sciences, Arts & Humanities. It indexes scholarly literature from journals, conference proceedings, books and other sources.

The publication records of institutes were searched using an inbuilt 'affiliation search' box. The searched records comprised year-wise number of records, total number of records in the three-year period (2016-2018), total citations received, average citation per paper and h-index. H-index is an indicator of quality of paper, researcher or institutes. In generic term, the 'n' h-index indicates that the unit of analysis has received at least 'n' number of citations. For instance, if the h-index of an institute is 25, it means that the institute has received at least 25 citations from 25 papers. This is one of the globally accepted indicators of good quality research. Research Productivity implies the number of publication per faculty in a year. This study also gives productivity rank of the top 100 where those institutes excel that have few yet focused faculty members. □

hen Professor Suman Sharma, principal of Lady Shri Ram College for Women, New Delhi, went to Coimbatore last year, Dr Nalla G. Palaniswami, the chairman of a number of colleges there, sought her out for a small conversation. He said he had been extremely concerned and worried about two girls from his village, because they were going to Delhi, and to an institution as prestigious as LSR at that. His worry had been misplaced, Dr Palaniswami

told her. When he met the girls six months later their body language had changed and they were oozing confidence. "How did you do that?" the senior doctor-turned-education-ist asked Sharma.

Sharma, who remembered the two and their story well gave the entire credit for mentoring them to the students of the college, particularly the seniors. For, the two girls had not only moved from a tiny village to the national capital, but had joined LSR without being fluent in English or Hindi. "Seventy per cent of our students come from remote parts of the country," says Sharma. "They come not just from small towns, but also rural backgrounds."

St Stephen's College, which has alumni that ooze urbane polish, also

has students who do not quite fit the widely held perceptions about its students. Says principal Professor John Varghese, "We do have a number of students coming from non-metropolitan towns, and they are here on the basis of their hard work. What brings them to college is their knowledge of the subject, and their aspiration to do well." It is like a great fire burning within, to do well for themselves, adds Varghese. However, they do face some trouble. "They come to college and find that their language is not perfect, that they are unfamiliar with certain practices, which Varghese says is second nature for city kids. "But these children pick up, and they do it very quickly," he says.

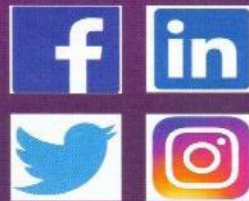

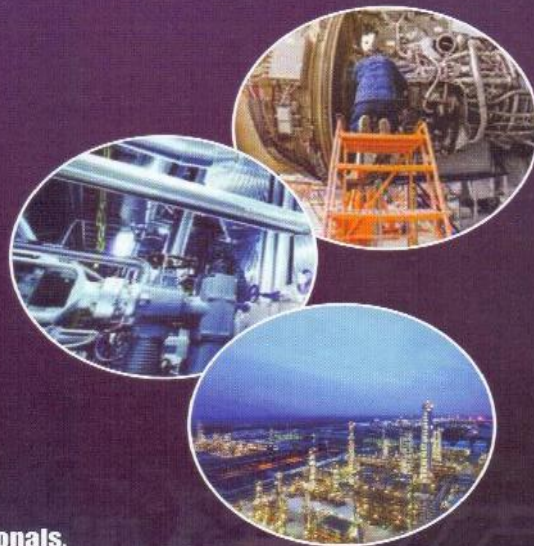

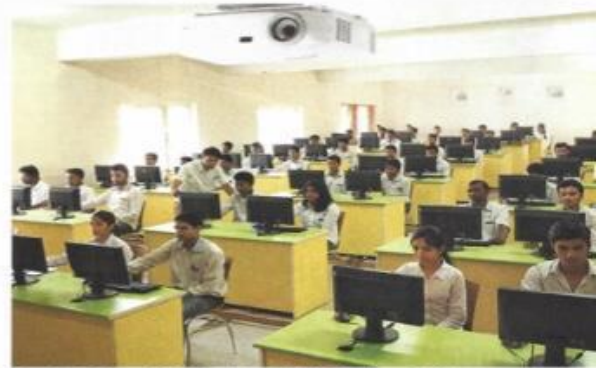
