SoRT in association with the Marrow Donor Registry (India) held a Bone Marrow Registration drive on the 12th of August, 2016 at the VESIT campus. The camp went on from 9 am to 5 pm in the evening.

A total count of 168 registrations were made by the students and the staff, all under the proper guidance and supervision of doctors from Fortis/Raheja Hospital. The sample collection of cheek epithelial cells was done.

The registration desks were managed in an organised manner by the SoRT team and the event was smoothly conducted. Also, proper information was provided to the people who registered about the further process of donation if a match is found.

The doctors were very cooperative and approachable. Spreading awareness about Bone Marrow Donation was very effective as a lot of people were unaware of this amazing way in which they can save a life!

SoRT VESIT in collaboration with marrow donor registry India, (MDRI) an NGO under the Tata Trusts are organizing a stem cell donor registration drive in our college on Tuesday (19/3/19) from 10am to 4pm in the boys common room.

Blood related disorders like blood cancer, thalassemia, aplastic anemia and other genetic blood disorders are on the rise which cannot be completely cured by medication. The only possible permanent cure is through a stem cell donation if the donor's DNA matches perfectly with the patients, the donation process being very much similar to blood donation, with a needle in the arm. Only a 4 ml blood sample was collected on Tuesday to enter their DNA in the national registry. The donor would be called in future if their DNA is found as the perfect match. This year there were a staggering **314** students/staff who came forward and successfully registered to the MDRI.

The event saw people swarming in to voluntarily help out people who are in need, in hopes that one day they will be able to save a person's life. With this positive attitude, we concluded the very successful marrow donor registration, and inched closer to have a positive impact on the society. *Towards the better, together.*
